Where and when do I need to pick-up my student(s)?

6 business days prior to the SEEK or Camp start date.

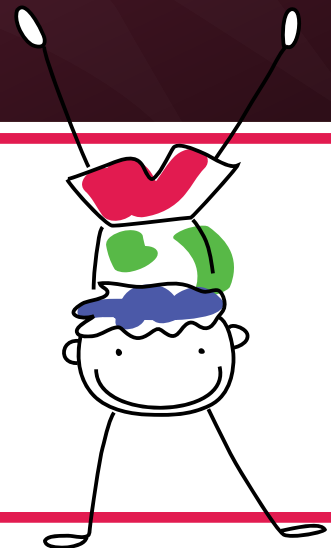
