- Fourth floor above-ceiling inspections
- Installation of third floor lab case work, wall panels and equipment
- Installation of first floor lobby floor tile
- Installation of fiber line termination and testing
- Painting fourth floor finish coat
- Installation of fourth floor carpet
- Installation of exterior building signage
- Installation of second floor carpet in the corridor
- Painting third floor finish coat
- Installation of third floor drop ceiling tile in the corridor

Current projects:

- Elevator startup will be completed Nov. 23.
- Air balancing will be completed Nov. 23.
- Fire alarm testing and flow testing will be completed Nov. 23.
- Startup of HVAC controls will be completed Nov. 23.
- Installation of fourth floor drop ceiling tile in the corridor will be completed Nov. 23.
- Installation of Bookstore and Coffee Shop countertops will be completed Nov. 23.
- Delivery and installation of furniture begins Nov. 28.
- Punch list and punch completion begins Nov. 28 and be on-going.
- Temporary certificate of occupancy (TCO) will be completed Dec. 5.
- Move in begins Dec. 6.

Project Cost/Details

The \$30 million, 85,000-square-foot building is projected to open its doors in spring 2017. The building will be home to several departments including Admissions, LCCC Bookstore, Student Records, Financial Aid, Counseling & Campus Wellness, Disability Services, Advising and Career Services and University of Wyoming Outreach. It will provide classroom, office and assembly space. The general contractor is FCI Constructors.
