Vision

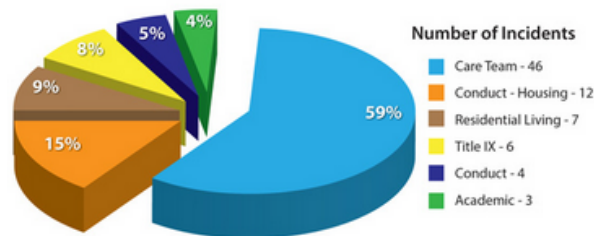
The vision of the CARE Team is that LCCC provides a safe and supportive teaching, serving, learning and living environment.

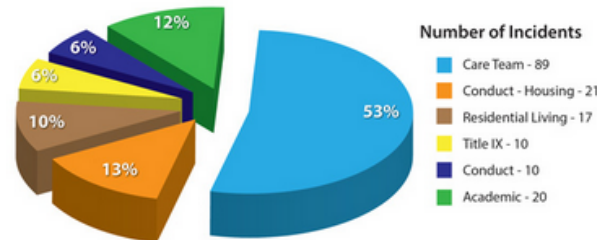

LCCC's philosophy of caring for students is demonstrated by the number of reports that are handled through the CARE Team versus student conduct. The graphic to the left outlines the breakdown of total incidents reported in one school year (fall and spring semester). The Conduct housing piece of the pie includes violations of the code of conduct, which occur in the residence halls on the Cheyenne campus. The residential living piece of the pie represents cases where staff are assisting residents in building a community. These cases include things such as roommate conflicts and mediated conversations and are handled by resident assistants and the hall director. The CARE Team handles the largest percentage of cases at LCCC with the goal of supporting a student through life challenges and ultimately to graduation.
