## **1.0 POLICY & PURPOSE**

The Board of Trustees of Laramie County Community College (LCCC) is committed to providing the highest quality of educational instruction to the College's students. To that end, the Board of Trustees expect that all faculty members at LCCC are appropriately credentialed for the discipline and subject matter they teach, while also meeting the criteria and assumed practices as required by the College's regional accrediting agency, the Higher Learning Commission's (HLC). The Board's expectations, in accordance with HLC requirements, provide that this policy apply to all of the College's faculty, including those in concurrent enrollment, contractual, and consortia programs.

Therefore, the purpose of this policy is to provide policy direction and direct the President to establish appropriate administrative procedures necessary for ensuring faculty possess the minimum faculty qualifications for compliance with HLC and quality facilitation of learning.
