



2016-2020 Shared Agenda

Goal 1: Ensure LCSD1 students have access to early college opportunities leading towards the completion of a valuable, identifiable “product” or providing advancement along a program pathway ultimately accelerating their completion of a college credential.

Primary Objective: Identify and offer sufficient concurrent enrollment courses allowing LCSD1 students to achieve the LCCC General Education Core which is also aligned to the UW University Studies Program (USP).

Goal 2: Increase the number of recent high school graduates that complete college-level mathematics and English coursework by the end of their first semester at LCCC.

Primary Objective: Convene curriculum alignment/articulation committees comprised of LCSD1 teachers, curriculum coordinators, and LCCC faculty to ensure seamless alignment of curriculum, specifically in mathematics and English.

Goal 3: Improve student transitions from LCSD1 to LCCC through stronger coordination of services, information sharing, and innovative programs to support students and their families, especially those deemed at-risk.

Primary Objective: Design and implement a voluntary mechanism for students to allow the sharing of academic and personal information between LCSD1 schools and LCCC to provide continuity in institutional awareness of specific student needs, goals, and other details that may help them succeed.
