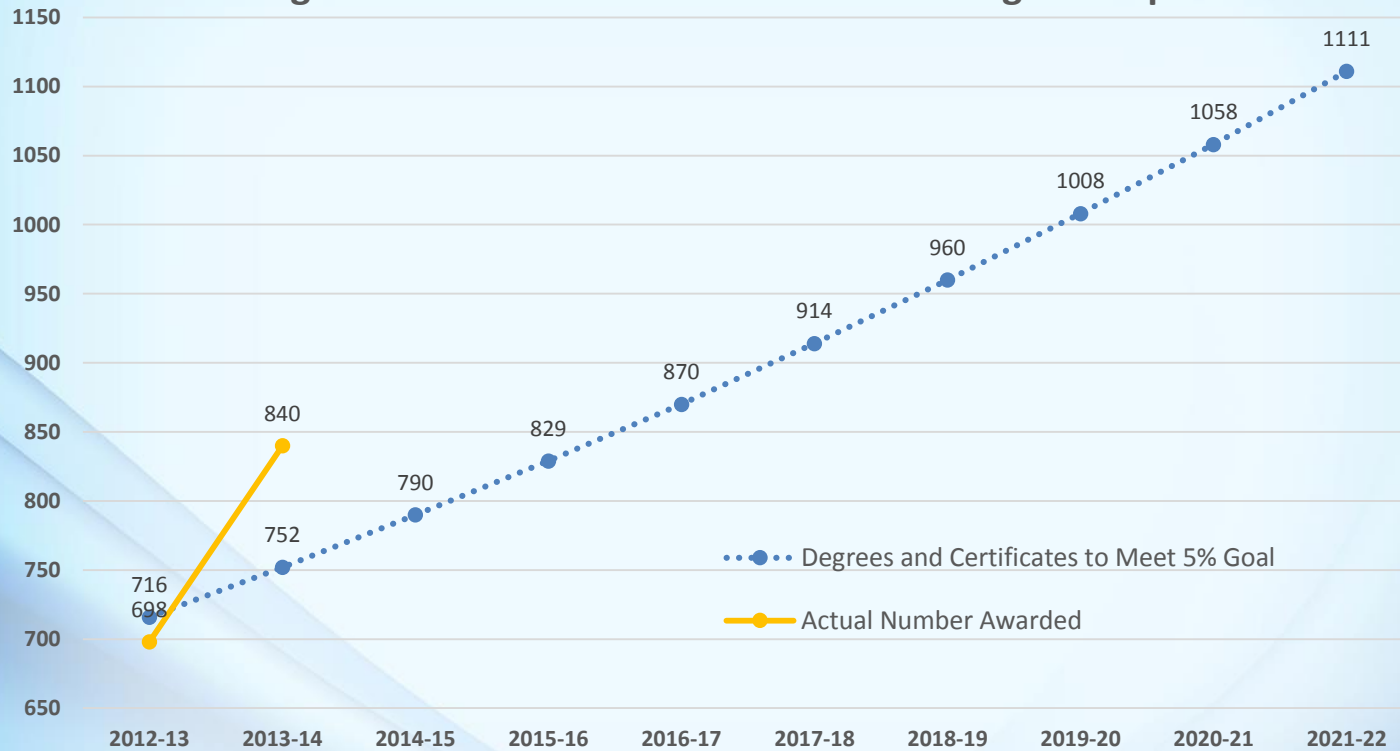


Strategic Plan
