General Information

CLEP and DSST offer students the ability to earn college credit by taking examinations on the material covered in a particular course. **LCCC does not award credit for general CLEP exams.** The college grants the same amount of credit to students who earn satisfactory scores on exams as it grants to students who successfully complete the course.

Transcript Entries

To qualify for credit by examination at LCCC, a student must be enrolled at LCCC. Credit by examination may be used to fulfill all degree/certification graduation requirements except for the mandatory 15-credit hour residency requirement. All credits by examination will be indicated as Transfer Credit (TR). No letter grade is given. Credit will be awarded only for exams for which there is a direct equivalent LCCC course. Credit earned by examination will be subject to all policies as stated within the LCCC general catalog.

Transferring Credits

Students should be aware that not all colleges have the same policies regarding acceptance of credit by examination. If a student is transfer-bound, it is the student's responsibility to find out whether credit by examination earned at LCCC will transfer to another institution.

Testing Guidelines

- Exams are computerized and timed. Most CLEP exams are 90 minutes. Most DSST exams are 2 hours.
- CLEP exams are purchased directly from CLEP and taken at an LCCC campus. See clep.collegeboard.org/clep-exam-registration-tutorial on how to purchase. **You must bring your registration ticket the day you are scheduled to test.**
- DSST exams require a school code where results will be sent. **Check with the school to obtain this code before testing.**
- CLEP/DSST tests are scheduled on certain days and seating is limited. An appointment must be made in advance. Students can call the main campus at 307.778.1105. Students who have access to F.E. Warren Air Force Base can call 307.773.2113.
- CLEP/DSST exams may be repeated in 90 days.

Testing Fees

- For non-military testers, a nonrefundable administration fee of \$20 for each exam is payable at the time of testing.
- A fee of \$85 is charged for each CLEP examination. Payment is made directly to CLEP when purchasing a test.
- A nonrefundable fee of \$80 is charged for each DSST examination payable online during the registration process. Payment is by credit card only.

All testing fees are paid by DANTES for eligible military personnel at both the main campus and F.E. Warren Air Force Base.
