

Kaplan Nursing Entrance Exam

In order to apply to the LCCC nursing program, you must successfully complete the Kaplan Nursing Entrance Exam. You will need a minimum overall score of 70 and a reading score of 73 on the same test. You can take the exam up to 3 times. You can take no more than two tests in a semester. There is a three-week waiting period between tests.

EXAM REGISTRATION

- By appointment only
- Photo ID (driver's license, LCCC student ID, military ID, passport, etc.)

EXAM DETAILS

- 91 multiple-choice questions. Computerized with immediate scoring.
- 4 subject areas: reading, math, science, and English
- Answers left blank will be counted incorrect, so make a guess.
- Scratch paper, pencil, and calculator provided

EXAM CONTENTS

MATH—Multiplication, addition, subtraction, and division of whole numbers, fractions, decimals, percentages, ratios/proportions. Conversion of fractions to decimals, percentages to fractions, etc. Word problems.

SCIENCE—Physiology systems: cardiovascular, fluid & electrolytes, gastrointestinal, hematological, immune, renal, respiratory, and sensory. Homeostasis and neurology included.

ENGLISH—Punctuation, grammar, sentence structure, paragraph logic, and passage development.

READING—Paragraph comprehension, passage comprehension, and inferences/conclusions

STUDY MATERIALS

- No specific review guide recommended. Check the Internet, LCCC library, or bookstores for a review guide. A guide that prepares you to take any nurse entrance test will provide an overview of the basic skills covered on the Kaplan test.
