- I. Call to order at 12:30 p.m.
- II. Roll Call: Hayley Greenawalt Absent
- III. Approve last week's meeting minutes amended by President Woolhether to indicate the previous week's minutes were amended by Vice President Goldfuss.
 - a. Motion made by Vice President Goldfuss to approve the minutes, motion was seconded by Senator Guzman. Minutes approved.
- IV. Theatre contingency Fund Request: Guest Jason Pasqua
 - a.
