HOUSING DEPOSITS: An application for housing cannot be processed unless accompanied by a check or money order for \$100 (U.S.) made payable to Laramie County Community College. The \$100 deposit is refundable if the student gives written notice of cancellation to our office no later than June 30. Cancellation after the July 1 date will result in forfeiture of the housing deposit.

HOUSING LEASE: The housing lease is for the entire academic year. A housing lease is a separate document and is not the same as a housing application. The housing lease must be signed and returned to the Residence Life Office. **Failure to sign and submit a housing lease may result in a cancellation of your housing assignment.** Students who fail to terminate their housing lease in writing prior to August 1 (January 2 for Spring semester applicants) will be held responsible for the remainder of the lease charges and will incur a lease buy-out fee as approved by the Vice President of Student Services. To cancel, email Reslife@lccc.wy.edu and give reason for cancellation.

Roommate assignments will be made on a first come first served basis and will be in accordance to the LCCC Non-discrimination policy, which states, "Laramie County Community College is committed to providing a safe and nondiscriminatory educational and employment environment.
