Progression to the fourth year of the ReNEW curriculum at the University of Wyoming requires students to have graduated with an Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) from a Wyoming ReNEW community college.

In addition students must meet one of the following two criteria:

- RN license and a nursing GPA of 2.5 **OR**
- No RN license and a nursing GPA of 3.0
