The Flavor Profiles of Beer

This course introduces students to vast array of beer flavors. Topics include: profiles of beer styles, sensory analysis (describing beer flavors), off-flavors in beer, brewing implications for flavors, and beer judging. Students in this course will learn how to properly taste and describe beers as well as how to accomplish/avoid certain flavors in beer from a brewing perspective. MUST BE 21. Fun with Dye – Fabric Dyeing

The first class will introduce fabric dyeing using MX dye. We will cover how to mix the dye to make solutions, how and what auxiliaries to use to make the dye solutions permanent, dye a six step value gradation from dark to light, a seven step color to color from an 18-step color wheel, and the rinse-out procedure. The second class will explore the different possibilities of direct application of dye to fabric. We will cover painting, stenciling, stamping, and over-dyeing pre-printed fabrics. The third class will explore different techniques for texturing fabrics by using different forms of applied resists and bound resists. (A kit is required \$25 at the first class.) A supply list will be provided to students at the time of registration.

This course will teach you how to solve cryptograms like an expert. Dozens of simple tips that anyone can learn will be discussed and practiced. The material is presented in a relaxed and interwoven format of lecture, demonstration, conversation, practical application, and individual assistance. Upon completion of this course, you can expect to make quick work of nearly 100% of the cryptograms in newspapers and puzzle magazines. All classroom materials are provided.
