1.0 POLICY & PURPOSE

A. LCCC strongly encourages students to seek medical treatment for themselves and for others when necessary. The College has a primary concern for the health and safety of its students. Therefore, students who seek assistance for medical purposes will not be disciplined by the College for any violation of the College's drug or alcohol possession or consumption policies in which they might have engaged in connection with the reported incident.

- 1) The purpose of the Medical Amnesty Policy is to increase the likelihood that individuals will call for assistance when faced with a drug- or alcohol-related emergency.
