## 1.0 POLICY & PURPOSE

The Board of Trustees are committed to ensuring effective decision making in all realms of the institution, including integrated information technology and data governance. The purpose of this policy is to promote and maintain the College's integrated information technology and data governance infrastructure in a manner that leads to student success and efficient and effective operations in support of the College's mission. The President shall be responsible for implementing procedures to ensure the systematic utilization of information technology and data resources, based on shared governance principles, including technology and data planning, project prioritization, and other administrative functions.
