Non-LCCC clubs get their own logos but LCCC based clubs do not. Discussion: Is there a way to find a compromise? Each club can have their name under the LCCC name. It causes too much confusion having too many logos at once. Club members change every year or two, and changing logos that often would cause confusion with new students or community members. Posters can have a banner with the club's name and design known to the club. Justin will send an example with information for clubs to reference on what is and isn't allowed with the standardized logo. The executive team will format an email to send to club presidents with all the information Justin gives.
