- I. Call to order at 12:30 p.m.
- II. Roll Call: Precious Black Elk Absent
- III. Approve last week's meeting minutes amended by President Woolhether to indicate the previous week's minutes were amended by Vice President Goldfuss.
 - a. Motion made by Vice President Goldfuss to approve the minutes, motion was seconded by Senator Guzman. Minutes approved.
- IV. Executive Reports
 - a. President-Reported that she did not have her meeting with President Schaffer. No report.
 - b. Vice President-Reminder that office and desk hours have started, so be sure to sign in when completing desk and office hours.
 - c. Ex Officio-No report, next board meeting is scheduled for Nov. 7
 - d. Treasurer-Reported a balance of \$3,833.00 in SGA's budget.

- V. Old Business
 - a. Update on Voter's Symposium on Voter's Education-President Woolhether and Senators KC, Guzman, and Babcock met with Joe Ramirez to discuss the logistics of the symposium on Thursday, Oct. 11.  - b. Officer Openings
 - i. Ex Officio Update-There are 2-3 candidates interested in the position and the Dean of Students is formalizing a method to choose the ex officio.
 - c. SGA Meet and Greet-Nov. 6 Flyers and Promotion
 - i. Senator Babcock will present a flyer for the event on Thursday, Oct. 18 to Senate. It was discussed that Senators may want to have 1-3 questions prepared to ask the student body and document responses at this event rather than leaving it completely open ended.  - b. Interactive Boards-Discussion on creating interactive boards on campus. Vice President Goldfuss pointed out the coloring board in the BT building. It was also pointed out that Campus Activities Board has provided these in the past. A space would need to be determined either in Crossroads or the Student Lounge.
 - c. SGA Involvement with Residence Halls-Senator Babcock would like to see more Student Government involvement in the Residence Halls. President Woolhether and Vice

President Goldfuss will follow-up with the Residence Hall Director and report back to Senate what will be required to make this happen.
