More donations for the school as well as more scholarships were mentioned. In person classes are up by 5%. A pilot program is being used to incentivize students in boarding states. These students wouldn't have to pay the out-of-state tuition fee. Instead, there is a different lower fee for students coming from a boarding state to LCCC. Part of the fiscal

year plan is to invest in more trade programs and improve the childcare center.
