- I. Call to order (2:01 p.m.)
- II. Roll Call- Quorum met
 - a. Absent: Senator Tillman
- III. Public Input
 - a. Stacy Maestas-Registrar discussed the soft launch and implementation of chosen name. The chosen name implantation is available to LCCC students and staff who want to use and be referred to with a different name than their given legal name. This will be beneficial to a wide demographic ranging from students who are transitioning genders to students who just prefer their middle name. Maestas-Registrar reached out to IT. The name change is universal... meaning the name, once put into effect, will result in the chosen name displayed in rosters, badges, and in Navigate. The name change is not legal. Any student can reach the page where you submit the name change request by visiting the Student Hub website, clicking on Your Information, and then filling out the Chosen Name Authorization Form.
 - b. Program Director for Business and Finance and Open Education Committee Representative (OER), Jeff Shmidl discussed recognizing the faculty who have switched to using open education resources for their classes. It is very difficult for faculty to find open education resources and provide free textbooks for students. In recognition of their efforts, faculty should be thanked publicly particularly by students. The OER Committee plans to mark in the schedule which faculty offers open education resources and free textbooks in their classes.
