 - viii. Not having enough tutors – trying by increase two adjuncts and having recommendations
 - ix. Try to have instructors dedicate some time to tutoring
 - 1. Writing center already does that and it works well

 - xi. Want tutors for every subject that get consistent requests for tutoring
 - 1. Always want a network for those who can't get a specific tutor
 - xii. Smart thinking

 - 2. Tutors are trained incredibly well
