What if my student becomes ill or has an accident?

Where and when do I need to pick-up my student(s)?

Drop-off and pick-up are directly at the student's classroom. Please have only 1 adult family member at drop-off and pick-up.

A responsible adult that the student knows well. Students must be signed in and out. Students are unable to meet their ride in the parking lot.

When does my waiver need to be turned in?

No later than May 31 for all camps and SEEK.

Can I make payments or register without payment?

No – payment MUST be made in full at the time of registration.
